REPENTANCE (2 Peter 3:9)

- Was there a time when I turned from my sin to God by trusting Jesus Christ to save me?
- If so, when? _____

SPIRIT CONTROL (Ephesians 5:18)

- Do I daily empty myself of sin and allow the Spirit to fill me?
- Am I sensitive to the Spirit's conviction and prompting?
- Is the "fruit of the Spirit" visible in my life?

GOD'S WORD (Psalm 119:105; Colossians 3:16)

- Do I read, study and obey God's Word daily?

PRAYER (Ephesians 6:18; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)

- Do I regularly pray for others (family, friends, leaders, poor, sick)?
- Do I pray faithfully for revival in my life, my church and my country?

PRAISE (Ephesians 6:20; 1 Thessalonians 5:18)

- Do I faithfully express my appreciation to God for who He is and what He does?
- Am I continually thankful for every circumstance God allows me to experience?
- Do I deflect praise to God and others when complimented for character traits and talents?



OBEDIENCE (Hebrews 13:17; 1 Samuel 15:22)

- Do I find great delight in doing right?
- Do I submit willingly to my God-given authorities?

PURE HEART (1 John 1:9)

- Do I keep short accounts with God (confess and forsake sin as He convicts)?
- Do I confess sin by name?
- Am I quick to forgive those who wrong or hurt me?

CLEAR CONSCIENCE (Acts 24:16)

- Do I consistently seek forgiveness from those I wrong or offend?
- Is my conscience clear with every person? (There is no one I have ever wronged that I have not returned to and made it right.)

MOTIVES (Acts 5:29; Matthew 10:28)

- Am I more concerned about what God thinks about me than what my friends think?
- Would I do what I do for God (pray, give, serve) if nobody noticed?

SACRIFICE (Philippians 3:7,8)

- Am I willing to sacrifice whatever necessary to see God do His will in my life and church?

EVANGELISM (Romans 9:3)

- Do I consistently witness and bear a burden for the lost?
- Am I ashamed of the "gospel of Christ?"

PRIORITIES (Matthew 6:33)

- Does my schedule tell that God is first in my life?
- Does my checkbook reveal that God has first place in my life?
- Next to God, does my family have highest priority?
